

Minutes

January 8, 2026

Commissioners present: Jeffrey Hunker, Timothy Bechtol and William Bateson

Also Present: Alec Helms, Cindy Land, Phil Johnson, Adam Witteman, Steve Wilson and Saige Thornley from the Courier.

Commissioner Hunker opened the meeting at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioner's 1st floor conference room. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes from the December 30th, 2025 and January 6th, 2026 meetings were read with Timothy Bechtol making a motion to approve, Jeffrey Hunker seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

William Bateson made a motion to approve three Warrant Journals. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0. William Bateson made a motion for the Board Chair's signature on the Certificate of the Total Amount from All Sources Available for Expenditures and Balance. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0. The Commissioners approved the December Fund Report, payroll for their employees and JFS employees, 2 travel requests for the Engineer, a travel request for the Treasurer and a travel request for the Sheriff's office.

The Assistant Clerk presented the following resolutions for consideration:

Resolution #7-26 – Authorizing payment of the listed and/or attached Purchase Orders. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #8-26 – Decreasing the Brownfield Coalition Grant Fund #2195 appropriation by \$637,677.55. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #9-26 – Decreasing the Treasurer's Delinquent Tax Assessment Fund #2199 appropriation by \$586.41. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #10-26 – Transfer of Hancock County Solid Waste Management District Tier Disposal Fees to the Tiered Disposal Fee Fund #5109. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #11-26 – Decreasing the Probate Court Computer Fund #2029 appropriation by \$25,349.26. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #12-26 – Decreasing the Domestic Violence Fund #2054 appropriation by \$256.00. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #13-26 – Decreasing the Juvenile Court Computer Fund #2083 appropriation by \$6,287.74. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #14-26 – Decreasing the Felony Care & Custody Fund #2121 appropriation by \$33,742.05. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #15-26 – Additional appropriation within the Auditor’s Certification- Commissioners to appropriate to Flood Mitigation Fund #4189. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Cindy Land presented the following resolutions for consideration:

Resolution #16-26 – Resolution authorizing a contract with the T & H Lift, LLC, to provide transportation services. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Cindy stated this a non-emergency transportation contract for JFS that is paid for with Medicaid funds. The total for the contract is around \$141,561.24. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Resolution #17-26 – Authorizing Change Order No. 1 to the contract with Great Lakes Demolition Company LLC of Clyde, Ohio, for replacement of HAN-MR520-0.00 (Morey Ave.) - Bridge, Findlay, Hancock County, Ohio. Cindy stated this is for a decrease of \$1,131.08 for a new contract total of \$638,018.72. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Phil Johnson presented the following resolutions for consideration:

Resolution #18-26 – Authorizing the purchase of a 2026 Chevrolet Silverado 2500HD 4WD Pickup with a crew cab from LaRiche Chevrolet – Cadillac, Inc., of Findlay, Ohio, to be used at the Hancock County Landfill for general operational purposes. Phil stated the total purchase amount is \$59,985.00. This will replace a couple of vehicles that are at the end of their useful lives and have no trade-in value. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Phil stated he is not presenting the next resolution listed on the agenda.

Resolution #19-26 – Authorizing the purchase of a 2026 Toyota Sienna Passenger Van for the use of Hancock Veterans Services in the conduct of its operations. Phil stated this vehicle will be used mainly in the transportation of Veterans within the county to medical appointments. The price is \$43,035.00 and is being purchased from Findlay Motorcars LLC. William Bateson made a motion to approve. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Steve Wilson stated that he has followed up on the discussion about the property transfers. He has reached out to Scott Hardin and hopes to have a map for the Commissioners to look at next week.

Meetings/Reports

Timothy Bechtol attended the LEPC meeting yesterday. He also had a chance to visit the Veterans’ new offices on Olive Street. He stated he was looking at the placement of the recycling bins and they have begun to drift south. There was a discussion about the bin placement and the

options for a barrier to keep them from shifting south over time. Commissioner Hunker stated he has a meeting scheduled for Monday with Rumpke.

Tuesday Commissioner Bechtol attended the Fresh Brewed Business breakfast at the MCPA. In the afternoon he met with Steve Welton about his office project. He is not addiment that his office staff will not be able to move to the first floor at all in the near future. Commissioner Bechtol stated he wants to get RCM under contract for the next phase of the courthouse work. Commissioner Bateson stated he also spoke with Treasurer Welton recently and he hates to go against his wishes, but we have a window of opportunity right now to get this done. Commissioner Hunker stated that we have county money invested in this project already and it will cost significantly more if there is a delay. He feels like this is already in motion and if the votes from the Committee of Seven are there then we must move forward. Cindy Land stated this is a security upgrade as well. Commissioner Bechtol asked if we can seek the bids and permits then revisit this before making the final decision to move forward with construction. Cindy confirmed that is possible. Phil Johnson will have a resolution to put this out for bid next Tuesday.

On Monday Commissioner Bechtol attended the Fair Board meeting. There was a discussion on the questions that were asked by Saige from the Courier in regards to the new Microtransit routes looking to be put into place.

Commissioner Bechtol stated that Chief Mathias has asked for a letter of support for closing Cory Street. There was a discussion on the different things that will go with closing the road. Commissioner Bateson stated he is in favor of the idea but will need some questions answered before he feels they can send the letter of support. Commissioner Hunker will reach out to Chief Mathias and try to set up a call for later this afternoon.

William Bateson had nothing to report.

Jeffrey Hunker had nothing to report.

At 10:30 a.m., the Commissioners met with Chad Warnimont from the Landfill. Also present was Alec Helms, Cindy Land, Phil Johnson, Adam Witterman, Steve Wilson, Lynn Taylor and Chrstine Carrigan. Chad stated he wanted to discuss adding another person on the road picking up litter with Dave. He explained his duties and why we need some with him. Commissioner Hunker stated we have someone on the recycling side that could devote time to helping Dave.

Steve Wilson provided a recap of 2025. He stated Chad has sent over the quote for the Dozer and we received the trade-in amount for the Loader. Steve asked about the continuation of the work orders with Mannik & Smith. Cindy stated she is going to have Justin do the resolution for them and he is available to present them to the Commissioners during next Thursday's meeting. Steve stated they are going to resurface the front entrance road to the landfill this year.

Chad Warnimont requested executive session in regards to personnel – compensation.

At 10:46 a.m., Jeffrey Hunker made a motion to enter into executive session in regards to personnel – compensation. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Roll call vote: William Bateson: yes; Timothy Bechtol: yes; Jeffrey Hunker: yes; At 11:08 a.m., Jeffrey Hunker made a motion to come out of executive session. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

William Bateson made a motion to change Chad Warnimont's pay from salaried to hourly. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

At 11:09 a.m., the Commissioners met with Jason Althouse from Soil & Water. Also present was Alec Helms, Cindy Land and Adam Wittenman. Jason provided updates for the projected 2025 projects and the 2026 plan of work. There was a discussion on the \$150,000.00 transfer into the ditch maintenance fund. The Board would like to complete that resolution next week. Jason also provided an update on the Gene Pugh petition and stated they will be finishing up the engineering soon. We will look to schedule the hearing once it is submitted to the Commissioners.

At 1:20 p.m., the Commissioners met with Adam Miller. Also present was Alec Helms and Lynn Taylor. The following items were discussed:

- The Olive Street roof repairs are quoted at \$2,746.00 but they could possibly find additional repairs needed when they are completing the other work. The Commissioners agreed to the work. Adam will send the information to Phil Johnson to complete a resolution.
- We received a quote of \$3,702.04 for a modular sign at the Olive Street building. The Commissioners agreed to the estimate. Adam will send the information to Phil Johnson to complete a resolution.
- Adam is still trying to get another quote for the canopy outside of the 514 building. Commissioner Bechtol instructed Adam to reach out to Scramblers about who installed theirs.
- The paint in the parking lot was still wet this morning, but they put some heat on with the torch. It looks like we should be able to reopen the parking lot tomorrow.
- They are looking to try to get the ivy cut off the front of the building next week. Maintenance will need to get a lift to be able to cut it off.
- Alec Helms stated that after looking at the parking lots it seems like 2 additional signs along the alley in Lot H are needed. The Commissioners agreed. Adam stated he will get with Fastsigns to get them ordered.
- Commissioner Bateson asked about the status of the repairs being done at the Jail. Adam gave an update of the projects.
- There was a discussion on the changes to the Cottages that will be needed for the new occupants
- Adam stated some files from the Clerk of Courts office have been moved to the old Juvenile Probate Court building.
- Adam provided a quote from Millstream for fabricating the bars needed for the windows at the Cottages and Nagy for powder coating them. The Commissioners asked him to get another quote for the work as well.

There was further discussion on the letter requested from Chief Mathias about closing or vacating Cory Street. If we do not hear back from the Chief an email will be composed asking the questions we would like to have answered before the letter is written.

At 3:00 p.m., the Commissioners reconvened their meeting to have a call with Chief Mathias from the City of Findlay Police Department. Also present: Alec Helms and Cindy Land. The Commissioners asked for more information on what Chief Mathias is wanting to do. Chief Mathias explained he is trying to gather letters of support to provide the Mayor and the City's

Safety Director. Then they will go in front of the traffic commission to look at next steps. He explained what will be used to close off the road and the parameters of the closing.

At 3:31 p.m., Jeffrey Hunker made a motion to enter into executive session in regards to threatened litigation. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Roll call vote: William Bateson: yes; Timothy Bechtol: yes; Jeffrey Hunker: yes; At 3:49 p.m., Jeffrey Hunker made a motion to come out of executive session. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 3-0.
