Many community members spoke in support of adopting the exclusion zones and stated they urge the Commissioners to pass the resolution today. Rob Kalbouss from Leeward, Pat Sadowski from Eastman & Smith and Tim Mayle from the Findlay-Hancock Alliance spoke against passing this resolution and urged the Commissioners to consider the new procedures due to Senate Bill 52 allowing them to approve or deny projects on a case by case basis. William Bateson made a motion to approve, Michael Pepple seconded. Motion passed 2-1.
