August 4, 2021-Special Meeting


Commissioners Present: Timothy Bechtol, Michael Pepple, and William Bateson

Also Present: Sarah Mutchler, Lucinda Land, Adam Witteman, and Kasey Corbet.

Commissioner Bechtol opened the meeting at 1:15 p.m. in the Commissioners' 1st floor conference room. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Kasey presented a draft copy of a plan design for the Juvenile Probate Court building. She met with Judge Johnson and staff earlier today to discuss the design as well. She informed the Commissioners of the requested layout changes. Overall, the design was well received and there are only minor changes to administrative layouts. William Bateson requested a large canopy over the public entrance to signify the entrance into the government space. Michael Pepple has reached out to Nathan Hall from the National Center to State Courts. Nathan is willing to collaborate with Kasey Corbet for the security of the government space. This collaboration will begin after the August 18 meeting to vote on the plans. The Commissioners clarified with Kasey that the estimate Garmann Miller provides will be from the roof to the foundation of the JC Penney space, excluding the areas that are designated for other county departments. Those spaces will be left as a shell.


