9:30 A.M.-Commissioner's Meeting

Commissioners Present: Brian Robertson and Timothy Bechtol

Commissioner Robertson opened the meeting at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioners' 1st floor conference room. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes from February 15, 2018 were read with Brian Robertson making the motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

The Clerk presented the following resolutions for consideration:

Resolution #124-18 – Authorizing payment of the listed and/or attached purchase orders. Timothy Bechtol made the motion to approve, Brian Robertson seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Resolution #125-18 – Agreement and certification for the inter-county adjustment of allocated funds from Hancock County Department of Job and Family Services. Timothy Bechtol made the motion to approve, Brian Robertson seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Resolution #126-18 – Additional appropriation within the Auditor's certification-Commissioners to appropriate to Probation Improvement. Timothy Bechtol made the motion to approve, Brian Robertson seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

The Commissioners signed travel requests for JFS and the Sheriff and initialed approval of an RLF invoice from HRPC.

Chris Long gave a report of where his employees are working today and also said that Gary Benner, one of his employees, passed away this weekend.

Brian Robertson informed Engineer Long that he has been contacted about a turn lane on SR 224 near Shady Grove. He explained to them that this was a State issue but they might contact the Engineer's office anyway.

Adam Witteman from the Auditor's office had nothing to report.

Sarah Mutchler reported that repairs for the water damage at the BMV have started and are coming along. She is going out to check on it this week.

At 9:40 a.m. the Commissioners are in recess until 11:00 a.m.


11:00 a.m. Bid Opening for the Phone System
