Minutes July 9, 2020

Mark Gazarek opened the meeting at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioner's 1<sup>st</sup> floor conference room. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Minutes from the July 2, 2020 meeting were read with Mark Gazarek making a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

The Assistant Clerk presented the following resolutions:

Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve the Warrant Journal, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0. The Commissioners signed 2 travel requests for the Sheriff's office, and the June Fund Report. They also initialed paperwork for HRPC to process the Revolving Loan Fund request.

Lucinda land presented the following resolutions for consideration:

Resolution #481-20 – Authorizing the Hancock County Commissioners in conjunction with the HCJFS to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between HCJFS and the Board of Allen County Commissioners for reimbursement for the cost of Allen County children in Hancock County care. Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Resolution #482-20 – Authorizing Change Order #1 to the contract with Tom Hiatt's Plumbing & Excavating Services Co. LLC for the installation of new home sewage treatment system as part of the Hancock County WPCLF Grant Project #HS390032-003-2020-07. Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Resolution #483-20 - Authorizing Change Order #1 to the contract with Tom Hiatt's Plumbing & Excavating Services Co. LLC for the installation of new home sewage treatment system as

part of the Hancock County WPCLF Grant Project HS#390032-003-2020-04. Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Resolution #484-20 – Authorizing a contract with A & D Excavating Services Co. LLC for the design and installation of a new home sewage treatment system as part of the Hancock County WPCLF Grant Project HS#390032-003-2020-08. Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Lucinda Land would like to defer the last resolution she has until after discussion during the executive session.

Philip Johnson presented the following resolution for consideration:

Resolution #485-20 — Authorizing entry into and execution of License Agreement for the use of real property located at the intersection of North Blanchard St. and East Main Cross Street in Findlay, Ohio as a staging area or laydown and equipment yard for the Blanchard-Lincoln Paths Project. Phil stated that Helms & Sons have used this area before for a previous project and there were no problems. This agreement includes an Indemnity Liability Waiver. Mark Gazarek made a motion to approve, Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

Lucinda Land requested an executive session to discuss threatened litigation. Phil Johnson requested an executive session to discuss pending litigation and threatened litigation.

Charity Rauschenberg handed out the year to date activity report to the Commissioners. She wanted to note that they received allocation of the COVID dollars at the end of June, in which the Commissioners should have received that information. The estimates stated that the county should have received around \$2.9 million and the actual receipts came in a little less, around \$20,000 - \$30,000 less so that changes the allocations. Some of the information that was reported was based off of estimates, so therefore, the Townships and Villages will not be receiving what was previously reported. Charity summed it up with a Press Release. The County's portion was a little more than \$1.4 million. On the Fund Report, the Auditor created a fund and it shows where \$2.8 million was received, and in July there will be movement of the \$1.4 million allocation. Charity stated that they have received several township resolutions requesting their allocation. The COVID dollars are based on a resolution that is received by the Auditor's office, and only when there is a resolution adopted in their office, which is a little different than other local funds that they are using for the distribution. October is the first deadline for reporting what has been spent. Charity talked about the Shared Work program that some elected officials have been doing and stated that the Governor had signed 50% reimbursement, and he has now signed 100% of reimbursement but not sure if that is retroactive. The first month, there was a savings close to \$30,000 and \$50,000 in the second month. Sales Tax information given in the article was for the month of March and was only half of a month of shutdown. The sales tax information received this month will be for the month of April and the preliminary numbers have a loss of 20% from 2019 July numbers, however, she stated that auto

sales for the month June showed an increase. Charity had a few budget questions regarding some of the resolutions approved today. The Prosecutor's Resolution #478-20 was one in question regarding reimbursement from Children's Services for legal work performed by the Prosecutor's staff. Mark Gazarek recommended she talk to the Prosecutor's office regarding that resolution. The next resolution, Resolution #479-20, Charity asked if that Change Order was for the Camera Project and Timothy Bechtol stated yes it was. Adam created a new report to help with the overall budget information and the first 3 months of 2020 really helped boost us to where we are now, sales tax being the largest revenue. Charity stated that they are finishing up the audit and on July 23<sup>rd</sup> there will be an exit conference and invited the Commissioners to be involved in that either by conference call or an in person meeting. That meeting is a State Auditor meeting and is not open to the public and will not be recorded.

Steve Wilson announced that the drainage project on 568/CR 180 has been installed. Also, the Vanlue drainage project is scheduled to start the second week of August.

Judge Reginald Routson stated that he will be using the Marathon Center for the Performing Arts next Tuesday for selection of a new grand jury to serve a 6 month term. The request was made to allow social distancing and to meet other guidelines related to COVID-19. There are 55 prospective candidates who have been called for consideration. The Judge stated that there is not sufficient space within the main courtroom at the courthouse. The Armes Theater within the performing arts building will also be used for an upcoming trial.

### Meetings/Reports

Timothy Bechtol attended the Old Millstream Foundation meeting and they allocated money as a donation to the Fair Board's fund raising campaign. The Fair Board is still up in the air regarding this year's fair. Tim has been in a conversation with the City of Findlay Engineer department regarding the parking lot south of the Library. There is a Memorandum of Understanding agreement between the City and the Library to replace sidewalks and to re-pave the site at the old 222 Broadway building. There was a suggestion to reverse the direction of that parking lot on the south side of the lot for safer traffic patterns. The City Engineer's office has a layout for the Commissioners consideration. There is an additional cost to spray coat the south lot and re-stripe all of it. The total cost of materials would be \$1,652.50 and the labor would be at the city's cost. Tim gave an update on the various projects at the jail. Currently the security doors contract is wrapping up this week. The plumbing work is well under way, however they did find some problems in the kitchen area and have submitted a change order to dig up the concrete and another change order for a broken stack. Phil Johnson stated that there may be a third change order coming regarding another location with a broken stack. Tim is working on the bid package for the interior painting and should have it ready for the Prosecutor's office by the end of this week so that it is ready for the Commissioners next Thursday to go out to bid. He would like to advertise that for two weeks in July so hopefully everything is wrapped up by Labor Day.

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Mark Gazarek reported that he met with the LEPC group, receiving the quarterly hazmat material spill update and gave a COVID update stating that there are currently no hospitalizations in Hancock County per the county health department.

At 10:12 a.m., Mark Gazarek made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss threatened litigation and pending litigation. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Roll call resulted in: Mark Gazarek, yes; Timothy Bechtol, yes. At 10:30 a.m. Mark Gazarek made a motion to come out of executive session, having discussed threatened litigation and pending litigation with no action taken. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

At 10:30 a.m. the Commissioners met with Len Armijo. Others present included Tammy Erwin, Mollie Welly, Phil Johnson, Cindy Land and Phil Riegle. At 10:40 a.m., Mark Gazarek made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss threatened litigation. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Roll call resulted in: Mark Gazarek, yes; Timothy Bechtol, yes. At 11:06 a.m. Mark Gazarek made a motion to come out of executive session, having discussed threatened litigation with no action taken. Timothy Bechtol seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

At 11:30 a.m., the Commissioners held the bid opening for 321 Clinton Ct. There were 10 bids that were received. However, we were informed this afternoon that a bid had been delivered by FedEx to the Hancock County Courthouse at 10:21 a.m. Unfortunately, that package was signed by the Deputy Sheriff at the security checkpoint but not immediately delivered to the mailroom. The bid will be opened at the public meeting Thursday, July 16<sup>th.</sup> We will not be able to provide a bid tabulation or an award recommendation until the bid is opened.
