

STANDARD TRAFFIC DISPOSITIONS IN HANCOCK COUNTY JUVENILE COURT

POSSIBLE COURT ORDERS

- Fine
- Court Costs
- License suspension for a definite period not to exceed two years
- Community control sanctions that could include probation, curfew, house arrest, electronic monitoring, drug testing, counseling, or placement outside the home.

COURT COSTS

- Moving - \$104.00
- Non-moving violations are \$75.00

PRIVILEGES

Can be granted with ANY suspension or reversion, however they can be granted for work and school ONLY. School – classes where you get a grade. No extracurricular, except band where a grade is given. Privileges include one trip to school and one trip home per day which allows a child to stay after school to attend practices or games. Privileges will be granted by the Court only upon a clean drug screen.

POINTS

Most moving violations are two points. Some exceptions are as follows:

Fleeing officer	6 points
Leaving the scene	6 points
Street racing	6 points
DUS	6 points
Any felony	6 points
OVI (A section)	6 points
OVI (B section)	4 points
Reckless operation	4 points
Speeding (30 MPH+)	4 points

MANDATORY ORDERS

- Non-moving offenses – none
- 16 year old committing moving offense within the first 6 months of having license
 - Court MUST revert license back to temporary permit status for 6 months or until age 17, whichever occurs FIRST.
- 1st moving offenses – none
- 2nd moving offenses
 - 90 day license suspension
 - Juvenile must complete a 6 hour driver improvement course at his own expense
 - Must pay a reinstatement fee to BMV
 - Must re-purchase temporary permit
 - Must retake drivers exam (written and driver's test)
- 3rd moving offenses
 - 1 year license suspension
 - Same requirements from 2nd moving must be repeated.

POINTS will be assessed by the BMV for EVERY moving. See POINTS chart.

MANDATORY ORDERS WITH OTHER CHARGES

- Leaving the scene** – license susp. 3 mo. to 2 yrs.
- Failure to stop for school bus** – fine up to \$500.00
- OVI/OMVUAC** – license susp of 3 mo. to 2 years, Court ordered treatment program, fine up to \$100.00
- Texting while driving** –
 - 1st – fine of \$150.00, 1 year license susp.
 - 2nd – fine of \$300.00 1 year license susp.
